INTRODUCTION

The old CD ROM Network (lib-srv2) has been replaced by two new CD ROM servers, lib-srv5 and lib-srv6. Lib-srv5 provides the Ultranet Server where we make images of each CD ROM Database and make it available to users. Lib-srv6 provides web access to the CD ROM Network.

The CD Rooms that are currently available include:

- Bibliographic databases
- Reference works
- Textbooks

ACCESSING THE CD ROM NETWORK (FOR STAFF)

NB: You will only be able to log onto the CD-ROM Network if Systems have installed the Client on your machine and have issued you with a username and password.

- In start/programs/ click on "Run this to access the library databases network"
- After the batch file has loaded it will ask for a lib-srv5 password: enter the password that systems has given you
- Then it will take you to the Ultra Net Client screen where you should click on the yellow key on the top toolbar.

• A login box will then appear (shown below):

• Type in these details:

Server:	lib-srv5
User:	(usually lib-srv4 username e.g. Mackilloppa)
Password:	Issued by Systems
Domain:	(Leave blank)

- You should then click ok and should be connected.
- To logoff click on the yellow key with the red cross through it.

ACCESSING THE CD ROM NETWORK VIA THE WEB

NB: You will only be able to log onto the CD-ROM Network if Systems have installed the Client on your machine and have issued you with a username and password.

- Click on the Netscape Icon to start Netscape Navigator.
- In the *Location:* box, type the following URL: http://129.215.145.24 and press <enter>.
- You should now see the following display:
